Subject : **NON-COMPLIANCE OF ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT AT JOHOR PORT BERHAD**

Dear All,

The above matter is referred.

We wish to draw your attention to our previous memo, Ref: (51) JPB/281-6/1 Vol. 12 dated 3 October 2025, regarding non-compliance with the Environmental Quality Act 1974 and the Environmental Quality (Scheduled Wastes) Regulations 2005. The memo clearly stated that no Scheduled Waste shall be placed, stored, disposed of, or abandoned at the wharf or within any Johor Port Berhad (JPB) premises.

However, based on our routine monitoring, several non-compliances related to Scheduled Waste and environmental management were observed. Such practices are strictly prohibited as they might pose environmental, safety, operational, and regulatory compliance risks to JPB.

In order to ensure full compliance with the Environmental Quality Act 1974 and its subsidiary regulations, all port users are hereby required to:

1. Ensure all Scheduled Waste is properly handled, stored, transported, and disposed of in accordance with the Environmental Quality (Scheduled Wastes) Regulations 2005.
2. Strictly prohibit the placement, storage, disposal, or abandonment of Scheduled Waste at the wharf or any areas within JPB premises.
3. Immediately report any spillage, leakage, improper handling, or unauthorized placement of Scheduled Waste to the JPB Port Security and Safety Department.
4. Ensure that no untreated, contaminated, or polluted effluent is discharged into drains, the sea, wharf areas, or any areas within JPB premises.
5. Ensure all effluent complies with the Environmental Quality (Industrial Effluent) Regulations 2009 and with JPB PSSD's approval prior to any discharge.

6. Ensure full compliance with all applicable provisions under the Environmental Quality Act 1974 and its subsidiary regulations at all times.

Failure to comply with the above requirements, the violator will be penalized according to below penalty structure:

1. First violation: RM1,000.00
2. Second violation: RM2,000.00
3. Third and subsequent violations: RM5,000.00

All penalties shall be charged to the respective responsible parties, and official notices of offence will be issued accordingly.

We greatly appreciate your understanding, continuous support, and cooperation in helping us maintain a safe, compliant, and environmentally responsible port environment.
