## RESTRICTION ON SHORE LEAVE AT JOHOR PORT BERHAD (JPB) FOR SHIPS' CREW

We wish to draw your attention to the matter previously addressed in memo (05) JPB/281- 6/1 Vol. 10 dated 7<sup>th</sup>. June 2023.

Through our routine observations and monitoring of JPB's activities, we noted that there are recurring safety violations related to the compliance with Personal Protective Equipment (PPE), particularly by ship crews during their shore leave in the JPB area. Despite the circulation of memo dated 7<sup>th</sup>. June 2023 to all shipping and forwarding agents, these incidents persist.

Since JPB's operations involve heavy machineries such as Rubber Tyre Gantry (RTG) and Quay Crane (QC), any incident involving human error in proximity to these machines carries the risk of severe injury or fatality. Therefore, the strict adherence to PPE guidelines is imperative to mitigate potential hazards.

In order to prioritise the safety of the Port and its users, a decision has been reached to commence the implementation of 'No Shore Leave' Policy for all ship crews within the JPB area with immediate effect.

We greatly appreciate your understanding, continuous support, and cooperation in helping us maintain a safe working environment for JPB.
