SUBMISSION OF SAFETY DATA SHEET (SDS) FOR DANGEROUS GOODS (DG) DECLARATION

The above subject matter refers.

Kindly be advised that any Port Users who intend to carry out import, export and/or transhipment of DG cargo via Port of Pasir Gudang (MYPGU) are required to declare the goods through Johor Port Berhad online system (i.e., VCS, MPTS, JCTS) within 48 hours prior to handling of goods.

As part of the emergency safety measures, all declarations of DG goods must be enclosed with Safety Data Sheet (SDS) upon the submission in the online system. Kindly note that declaration of DG goods under UN 3166 - Vehicle, Flammable Gas Powered or Vehicle, Flammable Liquid Powered or Vehicle, Fuel Cell, Flammable Gas Powered or Vehicle, Fuel Cell, Flammable Liquid Powered, require the vehicle declaration document or cargo manifest/bill of lading (BL) to be submitted in the system as supporting document.

The submission of SDS in the DG Declaration System will take effect immediately. Therefore, please ensure proper documentation for the online submission to avoid non-acceptance due to incomplete application.
