WITHDRAWAL OF SHORE LEAVE RESTRICTIONS FOR SHIP CREWS AT JOHOR PORT BERHAD (JPB)

We wish to draw your attention to the matter previously addressed in memo (10) JPB/281-6/1 Vol. 10 dated 22nd September 2023. This memo was issued to address non-compliance with Personal Protective Equipment usage among ship crews during their shore leave. However, due to specific circumstances, the Port Security and Safety Department decided to withdraw the above-mentioned memo, effective immediately.

To ensure the safety of all individuals using the port facilities, the usage of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE), including safety shoes, helmets, long pants, shirts, and safety vests, is <u>compulsory</u> in the operation areas, which include wharves, jetties, warehouses, and open yards. Therefore, we strongly advise all shipping agents to inform vessel masters to ensure their ship crews comply with the requirement to wear PPE when disembarking from the vessel during their shore leave or port stay.

In cases of ship crews failing to adhere to the PPE requirement, Johor Port Management shall impose a penalty of RM1,000.00 for the violation. All fines associated with these violations will be charged to the respective responsible shipping agent and official notices of the offenses will be issued accordingly.

We greatly appreciate your understanding, continuous support, and cooperation in helping us maintain a safe working environment for JPB.
